Dear ICC Member:

Many of our Members now have substantial accounts with the International Bank of Meekamaui (“IBOM”, see <http://www.ibom.biz>).

It is our understanding that the government of Bougainville and IBOM are working towards international acceptance of their international currency known as Bougainville Kina (“BVK”). It is also our understanding that IBOM is working towards gaining acceptance within the international banking community.

However, until such time as IBOM may announce otherwise, it is our understanding that at the current time the only bank that can process banking instruments issued by IBOM is IBOM itself.

Therefore, to facilitate business on behalf of our Members, the Internet Catalogue Club has recommends three methods through which BVK may be used to conduct business.

The first method is through ledger transfers between Members that have accounts at IBOM,; that is, one Member may pay another by simply transferring BVK from one account to another.

The second method is to use the “Obtaining Currency Other Than BVK” Protocol that may be reviewed in the GIDEON’S Gate Portal of www.chips-corner.com. This method may be used ONLY with prior approval by and the involvement of an ICIB Work Center with coordination with THE BLUE MILLENIUM FOUNDATION being required.

The third method is by issuing a Letter of Credit (“LOC”) to an ICIB Work Center that has been designated for this purpose, using the Protocol of “Legitimizing Instruments” as listed in CHIPS CORNER under “CLICK HERE FOR IMPORTANT NEWS REPORTS”. This method also requires preapproval by an ICIB Work Center, preapproval by a designated Work Center, and coordination with THE BLUE MILLENIUM FOUNDATION.

For any use of the latter two methods, a Member must be productively engaged in the promotion of commerce as discussed in Protocols acceptable THE BLUE MILLENIUM FOUNDATION.

When using the LOC method, it is our understanding, that any request that is sent directly to IBOM MUST be accompanied with a \$500 USD payment for processing.

However, requests that are sent to the designated ICIB Work Centers by proactive Members will be held by the Centers and not processed by IBOM until the \$500 payment is provided on behalf of the Member and of the Center through the funds exchange process. In other words, it is recommended that all Members avoid sending request directly to IBOM unless they are prepared to concurrently pay the \$500 USD to IBOM themselves. Plus, this could avoid penalties that IBOM might choose to impose for requests that are not in compliance with the above.
